## Transfer of Piping Components Business

Proterial announces that it has decided to transfer all elements of the Piping Components business operated by Proterial and its subsidiaries to OKAYA & CO., LTD. (hereinafter, OKAYA).

#### 1. Background and objective of the transfer

The Proterial Piping Components business has contributed broadly to social infrastructure development. For more than 100 years since our predecessor, Tobata Foundry Co., founded in 1910, began manufacturing malleable pipe fittings with the  $\& \mathbb{R}$  (Gourd brand), we have offered superior quality and a wide selection of products. In the field of fine flow products, we developed the SAM<sup>TM</sup> brand of mass flow controllers in 1987 and later acquired the Aera $\mathbb{R}$  brand to expand business and further support the semiconductor industry.

Upon thorough evaluation of the steps needed for this business to achieve further growth and development, we reached the decision that the best option for all stakeholders was to transfer this business to OKAYA and pursue sustainable business growth. OKAYA possesses firm management base that is supported by global and diverse development, and is capable of making sufficient growth investments towards strengthening manufacturing. Furthermore, OKAYA has a long history of transactions with the Proterial Piping Components business, OKAYA is deeply familiar with the business. As such, we believe the business will achieve synergy with OKAYA by combining the product portfolio of this business and with OKAYA's technical and sales strengths as industry experts.
